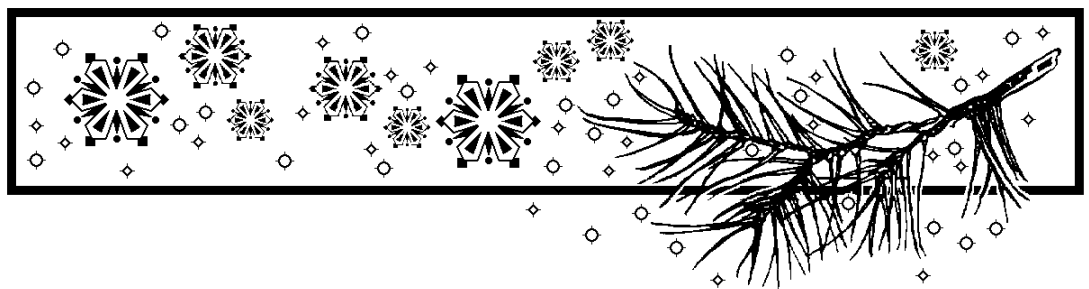
The Sound of Music
