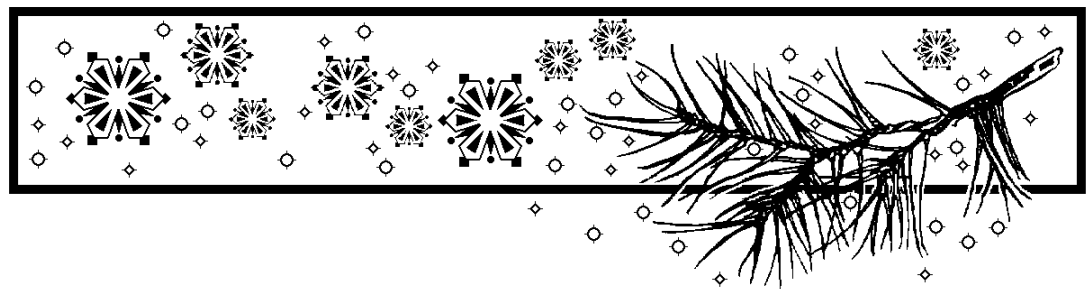
## The Sound of Music

## Chess Club

The ND Scholastic State Chess Tournament this year will be held on Saturday April 17th in McClusky, ND (see [www.ndchessnut.com](http://www.ndchessnut.com) then Tournaments for details).

The tournament has been held in Fargo the last several years, but is being rotated to a more central location this year. Oak Grove has won the team title in the 7th -> 9th grade section the last 4 years in a row. The scores from the top 4 players on each team in each section (K-3, 4-6, 7-9, 10-12) are added together to calculate the team score.

In order to encourage as many players from Oak Grove to attend as possible [and repeat our state chess championship title!], I will be driving one of the schools 15 passenger vans to McClusky on Saturday morning and then back to Fargo after the tournament.

The tournament is open to all our chess team members - no previous qualification is necessary. Also, players in grades 7-12 that want to earn an Oak Grove letter in chess must attend the state tournament in addition to attending chess team meetings and playing in local tournaments.
