Mission Statement of Oak Grove Lutheran School

The mission of Oak Grove Lutheran School is to express God's love by nurturing students for academic achievement, lifelong Christian commitment and loving service throughout the world.

Purpose of Award

The Hall of Fame will recognize those individuals who best exemplify the spirit, integrity and philosophy of Oak Grove Lutheran School. Alumni, faculty, staff, coaches, and teams who have made significant contributions and have brought honor to Oak Grove Lutheran School are eligible for selection to the school's Hall of Fame. We believe it is good and right to reaffirm Oak Grove's mission and Christian philosophy through the recognition of these individuals.

Background

Founded in 1906, Oak Grove is proud to recognize the significant contributions of individuals, which span the decades and generations of the school's history. Established in 2010, Oak Grove's Hall of Fame will induct a maximum of eight and a minimum of one individual per year; after five years, a maximum of five and a minimum of one individual will be inducted each year. While many outstanding individuals have graced our institution, competition for election to the Hall of Fame of Oak Grove Lutheran School reflects a very high standard. Those wishing to nominate individuals for induction should recognize the elite nature of this group.

Objectives

The objectives of the Hall of Fame are to:

- A. Give lasting recognition to outstanding individuals of Oak Grove Lutheran School.
- B. Lift up accomplishments which have been instrumental in creating a tradition of excellence at Oak Grove Lutheran School.
- C. Establish a public relations vehicle to further enhance relations between the school and its various constituencies.

CATEGORIES OF INDUCTION

Criteria for the Induction of Alumni

- A. The inductee must be a graduate of Oak Grove Lutheran School.
- B. There must be a lapse of ten years since the graduation date of the alumna or alumnus. (The Hall of Fame Selection Committee has the authority to give earlier consideration in unusual, outstanding cases.)

- C. The inductee must reflect the mission of Oak Grove Lutheran School, exhibiting Christian values, ethical behavior and good character.
- D. The inductee's achievements and endeavors while a student at Oak Grove.
- E. The inductee's outstanding achievements and service in his or her vocation, church and community after graduating from Oak Grove.
- F. Alumni serving on the Hall of Fame Selection Committee must exclude themselves from discussion of their own or a family member's possible induction.

Criteria for the Induction of Faculty, Administrators and Coaches

- A. Inductees must have completed their tenure at Oak Grove. (The Hall of Fame Selection Committee may give earlier consideration in unusual, outstanding circumstances.)
- B. Inductees must reflect the mission of Oak Grove Lutheran School, exhibiting Christian values, ethical behavior and good character.
- C. Inductee's dedication and concern for the intellectual, spiritual, physical and social development of students.
- D. Inductee's dedication to and promotion of Oak Grove Lutheran School.
- E. Inductee's outstanding achievements and service in his or her vocation, church, and community during and after completing his or her tenure at Oak Grove Lutheran School.

SELECTION COMMITTEE

Committee Structure

The members of the Hall of Fame Selection Committee shall be selected annually by the Board of Regents. The committee shall consist of no fewer than six and no more than 11 members. Terms of committee members shall be three years (April 1 to March 31), with a maximum of two consecutive terms. Members of the first Hall of Fame Selection Committee shall have staggered terms to provide continuity within the committee structure, as determined by the Board of Regents. The Committee shall elect officers: Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, Secretary and Treasurer, by a simple majority on an annual basis.

The Hall of Fame Selection Committee shall recommend individuals to be inducted into Oak Grove Lutheran School's Hall of Fame to the Board of Regents for final approval. The Committee shall be responsible for establishing and carrying out all policies and procedures necessary to ensure the proper function of Oak Grove Lutheran School's Hall of Fame. The Committee shall be responsible for securing funds to sustain the Oak Grove Lutheran School Hall of Fame.

Members of the Hall of Fame Selection Committee must exclude themselves from discussion of and voting on their own or a family member's possible induction.

Committee Members

The standing Hall of Fame Selection Committee will be comprised of a combination of the following:

- The President of Oak Grove Lutheran School, or designee
- Advancement Office Representative
- Director of Communications & Marketing
- Director of Finance
- Current or Former Faculty Member
- Oak Grove Alumni Representative
- At Large Members
