



## *Elementary School Frequently Asked Questions*

1. **What is the maximum number of students in each class?** *18 in Kindergarten, 19 in 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, and 22 in grades 3 through 5.*
2. **Do you have gym everyday?** *Yes*
3. **What lunch options are available?** *Hot lunch accounts may be established in any dollar amount. Lunches are electronically tracked and e mails are sent home when accounts are running low. Students are welcome to bring cold lunch.*
4. **How many students are in the lunch room or on the playground at a time?** *We have a total of three sections of classes eating and playing at a time.*
5. **Do you have foreign language opportunities?** *Yes, Coffeehouse Translations provides onsite language instruction in Spanish, French, Latin, and Mandarin Chinese for students at all grade levels.*
6. **When do students start sports?** *Basketball starts in 4<sup>th</sup> grade for both boys and girls. Students in grades 3-5 participate in the parochial school track meet in the spring.*
7. **Do you have an after school program?** *Yes, it goes from 3:00-6:00 for students K-5. It is operated by the YMCA.*
8. **Are parents involved in the school?** *Very! We have a very dynamic Booster Club. There are also regular volunteers in the lunch room, front desk and during recess. Classroom parents also help teachers with holiday parties.*
9. **What transportation options does the school provide?** *A shuttle bus runs between the north and south campuses to make drop off and pick up more convenient.*
10. **What are the regular school hours?** *8:30-3:05 for grades 1-5, Kindergarten is 8:30-2:50, AM Pre-K is 8:30-11:30, PM Pre-K is 12:00-3:00.*
11. **Where can I buy uniform clothing?** *Uniform clothing can be found in several stores such as: Kohl's, Target, K Mart, Old Navy, The Gap, JCPenny's, etc.*
12. **What music opportunities are available?** *Students in grades K-5 attend daily music classes, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> graders are members of the Grover Choir Squad which is a performance choir, and band begins in 5<sup>th</sup> grade. Voice, piano, and band lessons are available on an individual basis.*
13. **How much time do students spend in the library?** *All classes Pre-K through 5<sup>th</sup> grade visit the library once a week. Students also use the library for researching special projects and individual reading time.*
