



What to do if your student was EXPOSED to someone with COVID-19

Exposure or Close Contact = any individual who was within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes starting from 2 days before illness onset (or, for asymptomatic patients, 2 days prior to positive specimen collection) until the time the patient is isolated.

Symptoms include any ONE or more of the following:

- Fever >100.4
- Loss of taste and/or smell

OR TWO or more of the following with new or worsening onset:

- Fatigue
- Headache
- Muscle/body aches
- Chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Sore throat
- Congestion/runny nose
- Nausea
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Abdominal pain
