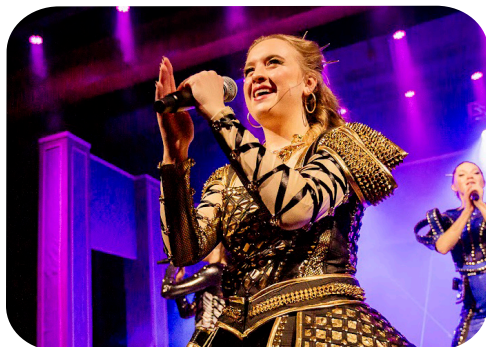
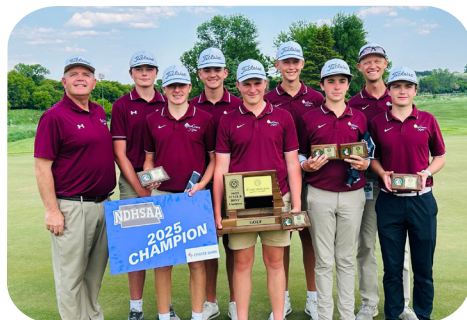

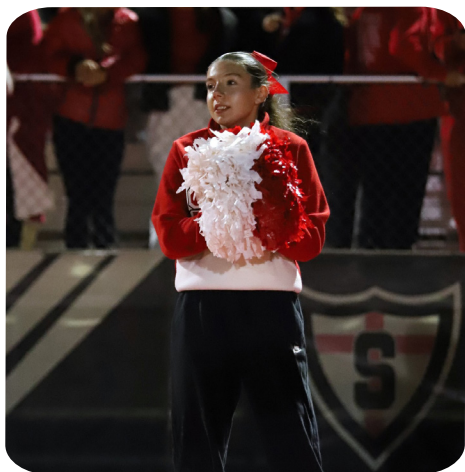

## Theatre Arts | Grades K-12

The Oak Grove Theatre Department boasts a robust season featuring productions for grades K-12. The theatre offers opportunities for everyone. Students can participate in many aspects of the theatre ranging from acting, set design & construction, lighting & sound design, hair & makeup, and costume design.

## One Act | Grades 9-12

One Act takes place as a class period during the school day. Students will learn about different aspects of theatre and compete in the regional One Act competition.

## Technical Theatre & Design | Grades 9-12

This opportunity takes place as a class period during the school day. Students in this course will learn the hands-on skills of planning, drawing, cutting, building and painting techniques by creating theatrical sets for the stage. This class will start with shop safety and move into the creative design, drawing, drafting and building process for theatre set designs.

## Musical Theatre Cabaret | Grades 9-12

This opportunity takes place as a class period during the school day. Students will understand the art of creating musical theatre characters. As an interactive class, students will engage with each other in the growth of all students' performances.
